Footnotes

HEY MACK jostled with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, engaged the leader while three wide on the far turn, edged clear when set down in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady urging. CHOCTAW BILL bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front of the field, raced off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and finished willingly for the place. METEOR ATTACK was taken up in the early going, bore out to be seven wide early on the first turn then dropped to five wide, lingered well back in the field, went two then three wide on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. ISHEAJET settled off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved out once straightened for the drive and improved position. THE DEUCE IS LOOSE raced five wide into the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. CAJUN DUST settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while near the inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. BURN RATE raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. MY BELL BOY set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, battled past the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. GETUSUM K. settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to menace. MY RISENSTAR bumped with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front of the field, chased four wide on the far turn and came up empty. STRIKE IT tracked the leader on the outside, made a bid between

rivals on the far turn, vied into upper stretch then capitulated. IDEAL ZARB settled towards the rear, raced near the inside on the turns and failed to respond.
