Footnotes

UPPERLINE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three wide on the far turn, was asked a bit near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, gained the lead outside the furlong marker and drew away under steady urging. CATEGORY SEVEN raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the compact field, bided her time while two then three wide on the far turn, was guided out behind UPPERLINE in upper stretch, came under the whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and got up for the place late. FOREST UPROAR settled nicely behind the solo leader, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, was asked while off the rail on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, gained a narrow lead shortly thereafter, was asked for her best in upper stretch, lost the advantage outside the furlong marker then failed to match strides with the winner and was caught for the place. VALLI WITH A VOW was taken under a tight hold early then reserved on the inside, drafted behind rivals on the far turn, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under the whip near the three-sixteenths pole and had nothing left. BORN INDY U S A set the clear pace, lost the lead inside the five-sixteenths pole, failed to respond when asked for more at the top of the stretch and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
