Footnotes

ON THE SAME PAGE stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, kicked clear when set down in upper stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, was eased up in the last two strides and just held. FINE ASSAY was restless in the gate then backed out and reloaded, dropped back under restraint early, raced inside on the first turn, moved up near the half-mile pole, was asked while inside on the far turn, waited while blocked from outside the quarter-pole to near the three-sixteenths pole, angled out over heels to get clear and closed fast to just miss. ELUSIVE KNOLL raced in the two path on the first turn, settled towards the rear, brushed with a rival leaving the backstretch, moved closer while two to three wide on the far turn, drafted behind rivals turning into the stretch, was roused outside the three-sixteenths pole, moved into second under a drive and proved no match for the winner then just held the show. COTTON CLUB CUTIE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside while towards the front, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch and was outkicked. MILLENNIUM STAR went two to three wide on the first turn, settled at the back while on the outside, brushed with a rival leaving the backstretch, moved closer while three to four wide on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. EXPAND THE MOMENT set the pace on the inside through moderate fractions, was asked near the five-sixteenths, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole and faded. MURU MURU saved ground on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, raced in the two path on the far turn and retreated. (Rail at 20 Feet)
