Footnotes

HEAVENVILLE broke alertly, was restrained off the leader down the backstretch, bid outside REDSUGAR turning for home, surged clear and proved best while kept to the task. DYNAPAC settled from early on, moved out approaching the turn, made a run at HEAVENVILLE in upper stretch, then while no match for that one, held second safe. PIONEERING NATIVE four wide around both turns while unhurried, split foes before the drive, closed outside but could make little impact. ONETHRESEVENBOX bumped entering the first turn, raced along the rail down the backstretch, rallied inside for the drive and was no real threat. TARGET FLASH forwardly placed off the rail to the drive, tired. REDSUGAR moved clear early, then faltered once overtaken entering the drive. JOSIAH crossed to the inside early and was outrun. TUPELO PLAYBOY showed little. BRAVE DAY got out entering the turn bumping ONETHRESEVENBOX, then was never dangerous.
