### Footnotes

BATTLE PLAN four wide early, advanced three wide entering the first turn, moved clear and to the rail from outside BIG POLK A DOT before reaching the backstretch, set the pace thereafter and proved best while kept to the task. GENERAL QUARTERS angled in early going to the first turn, was unhurried in the run down the backstretch, came three wide around the second turn, made a run at BATTLE PLAN and then while no match for that one was second best. AWESOME GEM inside to the second turn, awaited room behind rivals, split foes after entering the drive, was switched out to rally and got up for the show. STAR GUITAR forwardly placed off the rail, loomed approaching the drive, then failed to sustain his bid. GIANT OAK raced inside to nearing the drive, angled out turning for home and then could make little impact. STONES RIVER well back to before the drive, swung widest and passed beaten foes. STONEHOUSE allowed to settle, rallied three wide around the second turn and then flattened out. TONE IT DOWN raced inside and faded. HOLD ME BACK stumbled after the break and was not a factor. BIG POLK A DOT moved clear early, was displaced by BATTLE PLAN, before reaching the backstretch, held a forward position to midway around the second turn, then stopped.
