MACHO REGENT was rated just off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied to make a bid entering the final furlong and inched clear under right hand urging. CUPID'S HIT showed good speed then pressed the leader, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, bobbled passing the three-eighths pole, came three wide into the stretch, rallied passing the three-sixteenths pole, made a bid between rivals entering the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the place. LONELY NIGHT SKY bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. SUMKINDAHOUSBURNER broke a bit slow, settled near the back, raced four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly. BET I'LL B BETTER was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and also finished willingly. STEELY RAN showed good speed and set the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, was

set down in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened late. GLENDA'S MAHALO moved up on the outside, engaged the leader while three to four wide on the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong then tired. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L raced between rivals, was under steadying restraint from the half-mile pole to the seven-sixteenths pole, went three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. FREEBIE GOLD bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, made a bid between rivals on the turn, battled into upper stretch then gave way. HOT ROD OVERTON was urged along between rivals early then taken in hand, dropped back leaving the backstretch and failed to respond. TIGER TAYLOR was well placed on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. (Rail at 0 Feet)
