MEAN MOTA SCOOTA bumped with a rival after the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, gained ground in upper stretch, dove to the inside coming to the furlong marker, closed fast along the rail to get the lead then drew clear under steady urging. PACKARD showed good speed on the inside then dropped back, chased near the inside on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and earned the place while no match for the winner. ROY LEE bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, gained the lead passing the furlong marker but weakened and missed the place. DOUBLE R DIAMOND bumped with a rival after the start then dropped back, raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn and improved position. EL IDO was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. POLISH LIGHT bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace on the outside, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and tired. WARRIOR was urged along in the front half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. I KNOW YOU SEE IT showed good

speed and set the pace, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. PLAISANCE PRINCE moved in while urged along off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. SUPAFLY TY was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and also failed to respond. HOURCHANGINGFUTURE dropped back while ridden along and showed little. BONESINABOX broke awkwardly and was off slow, dropped well behind the field and was eased then walked off.
