JUUU bumped with a rival after the start, was urged along in the middle of the field, moved out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed fast to take the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear into the final furlong and proved best while drifting out some late. ROMP IN HOME was in tight after the start, raced well back in the field, steadied along the rail leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, gained ground along the rail in upper

stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. BOUND FOR GLORY was ridden along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. I'M NAUGHTY TOO was urged along towards the back, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and improved position. GRUMPY JIM pressed the early pace then chased, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. EXCLUSIVELY MINE was reluctant to load, raced well off the pace while urged along and failed to rally. DIABLO'S HOLIDAY bumped with a rivals after the start, was urged along towards the front, saved ground on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lacked room nearing the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. DONNA'SZIPPYD'JOUR bumped with a rival after the start, was hustled up on the inside, dueled with NINE FREE, battled into upper stretch then gave way. SA HOSS was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and also failed to rally. STEP N IT UP was urged along on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. NINE FREE showed good speed, dueled on the outside and tired. MONDON was off a couple of lengths slow, raced near the back while ridden along, went three wide on the turn and was no factor. CITIZEN'S ATTITUDE lacked early speed, checked sharply leaving the backstretch and never reached contention.
