Footnotes

PIC GOLD was last away, raced two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved well off the pace, moved closer while two to three wide early on the far turn, shifted four wide late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch, lugged in a bit under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, was switched to a left-handed whip, rallied on the outside under continued left hand urging, gained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under a hand ride. VICTORY TOUGH settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished with good courage to get the place. LUCKY FUNGO went three wide on the first turn, was well placed behind the solo leader, made a bid leaving the backstretch, inched clear under her own power at the quarter-pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, was asked inside the furlong marker, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was overtaken then lost the place at the wire. REPENTACIOUS went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved off the rail in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. KISS A CAJUN went four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged while off the rail on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. TIGRESS QUEEN went four wide on the first turn, was rated in third position, chased three to four wide on the far turn and tired. NAT NICOLE ROBIN raced five then four wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, went two to three wide on the far turn and showed little. IMATOPCAT set the clear pace, was challenged leaving the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. SUNLAKER went four then three wide on the first turn, raced well back in the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and was outrun. HO LOTTA CHROME settled on the inside, was through early and retreated. VET SCHOOL went four wide on both turns and faltered.
