CRAZY LUCKY tracked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid coming to the quarter-pole, edged clear under a strong hand ride outside the furlong marker, shied from a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole then proved much the best under a hand ride. SEPARATION showed speed then dropped just off the pace, drafted behind the pacesetter while a bit off the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly while second best. NATTY BOH showed good speed then moved clear, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner outside the furlong marker and weakened while just able to get the show. DREAMY DIVA settled off the early pace, moved up towards the inside near the seven-sixteenths pole, checked sharply leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, angled out some near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally then missed the show. MERVEILLEUSE settled at the rear while on the outside, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch, went four to five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CONTACT was urged along while off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch and came up empty. Following a stewards' inquiry and jockey claim of foul, SEPARATION was disqualified from second and placed fourth for interference at the three-eighths pole. (Rail at 15 Feet)
