Footnotes

IN STEP DANCER broke through the front of the gate prior to the start, chased the pace on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead, drifted out in the final furlong and held under strong urging. ASTRAL was reluctant to load, brushed with a rival early, raced off the pace while under some restraint, was guided around the turn while two to three wide, angled out sharply behind horses in upper stretch, gained ground on the outside of the winner, chased that rival into the final furlong, loomed boldly while being carried out and missed. EDOLIE brushed with ASTRAL early, was coaxed along while off the pace, raced five wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. CLASSICSAVY settled on the outside, went six wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly but missed the show. SO HEAVENLY stumbled at the start, spotted the field a couple of lengths, raced at the rear of the field, shifted five wide late on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and improved position. AVALANCHE PASS settled off the early pace, moved up while in hand late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but was outkicked. STONE COLD CRAZY stumbled at the start, spotted the bulk of the field about three lengths, settled towards the rear, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch

and lacked the needed response. WISESTAR showed good speed, contested the pace while in hand, vied three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and tired. ROSESINTHERAIN disputed the pace on the inside of WISESTAR, vied off the rail on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. (Rail at 15 Feet)
