SENIOR HAMBONE was well placed in third position, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, inched clear at the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under his own power in upper stretch, was asked near the furlong marker and proved much the best while ridden out. CANEROS showed speed then moved clear, lugged out while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead to the winner, chased that rival in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and was second best. SAFELY SPUN raced towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved off the rail in upper stretch and got up for the show. GRAND AVENUE showed speed then chased the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn and tired then lost the show. UNION WORKER was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. FIRST BORN FOR ME hesitated at the start then was slow into stride, passed a few rivals while well off the pace, climbed a bit while behind horses at the half-mile pole, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide late on the bend, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. BUNKHOUSE was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. PILOT JON bumped lightly with BORREGO'S SONG at the start, lacked early speed, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. THIRTY ONE ALWAYS veered out at the start and dropped back, was ridden along on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn,

floated six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. BORREGO'S SONG bumped lightly with PILOT JON at the start, raced towards the rear, went two to three wide on the turn and showed little.
