RACING FOR RICHES restrained while back early, split foes nearing the drive, steered outside to mid track, accelerated quickly to take over before the final sixteenth and proved clearly best. THE LADY EXCAVATE gained position down the backstretch, was reserved around the turn and rallied late between foes. NAT AND JULIE clear early, remained clear then faltered late. SUNSHINE CLASSIC raced inside until the drive, eased out and lacked a serious rally. MIDNIGHT JUDGE within striking distance, tired. LADY LYRA LEE close up, gave way. HIGH HOPES IRISH moved to the rail early and then was not a factor. BAWL wide early, was outrun.
