MILWAUKEE MIRACLE devoid speed, circled foes while rallying, closed willingly and was clearly best. BREAK UP unhurried early, rallied outside and was along for second. SILENT PIPE cleared to the inside around the first turn to set the pace, opened up nearing mid stretch, then weakened late. REW'S BLUES within striking distance, lacked a finish. TAKIN' THE BULLET between foes, could make little impact. MR. R. B. I. saved ground to no avail. WING A DING unhurried, was no real threat. CHOCTAW BILL was outrun. DESSY stalked SILENT PIPE to nearing the drive, then gave way. LEESTOWN GIFT showed little. SMOOTHCIDEUP forwardly placed for a half, retreated. PERSONAL VELOCITY was never dangerous. SEA THE SOLDIER was always back.
