ZIPING AWAY showed good speed, set the pace while off the inside, went two then three wide on the turn, floated four wide into the stretch, drifted out while under a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip near the eighth-pole, straightened out for a few strides, drifted out again under continued right hand urging in the final furlong and held sway. BANDED settled near the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the turn, chased under the whip in upper stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong, drifted out while trying to get past the winner and finished willingly for the place. ORIGINAL KITTEN chased the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased while being carried out by the winner, moved well out in the course and finished willingly for the show. ARCHERETTE raced just off the pace while on the outside, chased three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, moved well out in the course while pursuing the winner and was outfinished while able to get the show. MAGGIE SIMON brushed with PHONE MARYBE at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. JEALOUSOFMYBOOGIE stumbled at the start, settled on the outside, went five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. PHONE MARYBE lunged at the start then brushed with MAGGIE SIMON, threw her head and unseated the rider. (Rail at 15 Feet)
