Footnotes

ACACIAN SPICE contested the pace on the inside of ENVOY'S PRODUCTION, vied along the rail on the turn, shook clear when asked after turning into the stretch, was given one crack of a right-handed whip coming to the furlong marker then drew off under a hand ride. ENVOY'S PRODUCTION disputed the pace on the outside, was asked after straightening for the drive, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match while able to get the place. PHARME'S MISSTEAK brushed with HEBREA near the five-eighths pole, settled towards the back, went three then four wide on the far turn, tipped out an additional path after turning into the stretch, came under an all out drive and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. DAWN'S TRIBUTE was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind the pacesetter while inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and weakened. TRUE BREW advanced near the half-mile pole, moved up while three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and came up empty. HEBREA brushed with PHARME'S MISSTEAK near the five-eighths pole, settled at the rear, went four then five wide on the turn and failed to respond. OMAMAOMAMA broke a bit slow, advanced outside near the half-mile pole, moved closer while four wide on the turn and faded. TRESS was hustled from the start, tracked the pace, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and stopped.
