STONE FREE tracked the pace on the backstretch, chased while off the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, gained the lead passing the eighth-pole, battled with ZIPPY WAGER in the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. ZIPPY WAGER set the clear pace, raced inside on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the eighth-pole, battled with the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the place. QUITE EXPLOSIVE settled towards the rear, went two to three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. PATER FLATTER was coaxed along in third position, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. CAPE TOWN BRIDE settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. SECRET HEIRESS settled in the middle of the field, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. PAPER SHREDDER settled on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. GRAND ILLUMINATION raced well back in the field, dropped towards the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. RED BEAN ICE CREAM was void of speed, dropped well behind and trailed throughout.
