LUCKY LOU chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn, made a bid passing the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. C'MERE LUCY broke near the back of the field, settled while under some urging, raced near the inside on the turn, moved out while under a drive in upper stretch and closed strongly but was too late. R U'S GOLDEN LADY brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, dropped to the inside midway through the turn, made a bid between rivals in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. PAPER SHREDDER brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened. PHATSY'S DREAM was last away, raced well back in the field, went two to three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. ELLUSIVE WILDCAT brushed with rivals at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, advanced on the outside, continued five wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and came up empty. BE A PRO set the pace under some pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead near the quarter-pole, battled inside in upper stretch, steadied against the rail passing the furlong marker and dropped out.
