TRUTHORFICTION brushed with rivals at the start, showed good speed, set the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and just held under strong urging. SMARTY GRAS raced just off the pace while on the outside, went four to five wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, battled with the winner in the stretch and just missed. KITTY BLONDE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was rated on the inside, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, moved back towards the inside, was put to a drive, battled determinedly in the final furlong but missed. EDDIE'S BAND broke a bit slow, moved up on the backstretch, went three wide on the turn and finished willingly but missed the show. DIXIE'S CAT CAN DO settled off the pace, went four wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished with good energy. QUIETDETERMINATION settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and also finished with good energy. HANG ON TIGHT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was taken in hand while off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn,

moved out some in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. KNIGHT OF HONOR brushed with a rival at the start, dropped back off the pace, went three wide on the turn, moved to the outside and failed to rally. HUDSON'S CREED raced just off the pace while off the rail, came under a drive in upper stretch and capitulated. SHERIFF'S BIG GUN brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, vied into upper stretch and gave way. (Rail at 22 Feet)
