**Footnotes**

AUNTIE'S KITCHEN was restless in the gate, set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead late on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, inched clear into the final furlong and just held while drifting out some under strong urging. RAZZDAZZ raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well but just missed. NORTHERN CHILL moved out early on the first turn, tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, battled with the winner in upper stretch and tired while able to hold the show. EAST LOUISE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WHODAT SOEASY was well placed on the inside, chased on the far turn, bumped lightly with SECRET INFORMATION in upper stretch and weakened. SECRET INFORMATION saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, advanced four wide on the far turn, bumped lightly with WHODAT SOEASY in upper stretch and capitulated. TENSAS EURO went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. CUT THE DECK lagged at the rear of the field, raced off the rail

on the turns and failed to threaten. DANCEAWAY ROSSI broke about four or five lengths behind the field, went three wide on the first turn and was no factor. SHESA GOLD CAT raced towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and showed little. SHESA LOUIE broke a bit slow then was hustled with the whip, went four to five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, was rated just off the pace while on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and faded.
