ZEB tracked the leader, chased three wide on the turn, gained the lead near the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. CLOSE ALLY settled at the back of the compact field while under some urging, steadied near the three-eighths pole, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to secure the place. HEIR JOE settled on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. TRELAWNY showed good speed, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead near the furlong marker and weakened. DELANO settled on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. RED STRIKE settled off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. (Rail at 22 Feet)
