Footnotes

UNTAPABLE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, kicked clear under three cracks of a left-handed whip in upper stretch then drew off while ridden out under a hand ride in the final furlong. FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD was restless in the gate, broke very well, set the pace in the two path through moderate fractions, lost the lead while under urging late on the far turn, dropped to the rail turning into the stretch, fell well behind the winner while under a drive and proved no match but outfinished UNBRIDLED FOREVER for the place. UNBRIDLED FOREVER went four wide on the first turn, settled in third position while on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch a half length behind the winner, dropped back under a drive and tired while able to get the show. MARY RITA settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond. ARTIST CRY raced in the two path on the first turn, lagged well behind, was urged along while off the rail early on the far turn, dropped closer to the inside late on that bend and was no factor.
