Footnotes

BAND OF FUN set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, battled with BERTIE'S PLANET in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. BERTIE'S PLANET went three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, made a bid on the far turn, battled with BAND OF FUN in the stretch and just missed. MAGICAL RULER settled while off the inside, was urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. ARCTIC COMET settled well off the pace, was roused on the far turn, came out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. DYNABIRD lingered well back in the field, was urged along on the far turn and also failed to threaten. CAPTAINWOODROWCALL lagged well back in the field and was no factor. DEELIGHTFUL ANGEL was a bit rank early, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. RATE went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. MUSIC MOGUL went three wide on the first turn, raced well back in the field, went two to three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, was forced out sharply near the furlong marker and never reached contention. BLUEZY raced five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was

urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch, swerved out near the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. PALMER TOUR broke out at the start, was rated just off the pace while on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped then was eased but walked off.
