IDE BALL pressed the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the turn, inched clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. JOYCE'S REBEL settled just off the pace, bided his time while two to three wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match while able to get the place. SILENT PIPE was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TACKY ANGEL broke a bit slow, dropped well behind and failed to threaten. LYD RIVER broke a bit slow, moved up on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and tired. BEANEVELENT FUN set the pace under pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and gave way. GO FUZZY was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and came up empty.
