Footnotes

PARTY TIES settled on the inside, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive, chased TEN TO MIDNIGHT into the final furlong and battled determinedly to get up at the wire. TEN TO MIDNIGHT lugged out entering the first turn, contested the pace while hard to rate, bumped hard with SOUTHERN ROYALTY near the three-eighths pole, inched clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was denied. SWOROVSKI went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and finished willingly for the show. MIDNIGHT HEIST raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved while a bit eager, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, steadied approaching the furlong marker and failed to rally. REGAL ROSSINI settled near the back while on the inside, moved up with a half-mile to run, was asked at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. GRAND QUAKE raced four to five wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied four wide on the far turn and gave way. CURSELIKEASAILOR went four wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. SOUTHERN ROYALTY bumped with a rival after the start, went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was well placed just behind the leaders, bumped hard with TEN TO

MIDNIGHT near the three-eighths pole, went two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. LOOKDONTSTART bumped with a rival just after the start, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. MORE D'ORO went three wide on the first turn, moved up with a half-mile to run, raced four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. (Rail at 22 Feet)
