TRULY JUDY was urged along while off the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead passing the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under strong urging. JENINE'S PIC showed good speed, set the pace, dueled inside on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. EMERALD IDE CAT bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. LITEFOOTSUE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, moved out late and failed to rally. WASHINGTON NIGHT was urged along while off the pace, lugged out a bit while three then four wide on the turn and tired. HEBREA was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. KALEIDOSCOPE IDES raced well back in the field, went two to three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, altered course near the sixteenth-pole and also failed to threaten. LUNARLOR was last away then bumped with a rival and dropped back, raced at the rear of the field, went three then four wide on the turn and never reached contention. STORMIN LEAKY bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, chased the pace, dueled outside on the turn and weakened. SISTER SIP came out at the start and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field, went two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. ASHLYN'S PASSAGE was urged along towards the front, raced four then five wide on the turn and came up empty. PHYLIS UPWITH CASH was urged along on the inside, came off the rail on the turn and capitulated. LOU'S LAST settled towards the rear, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail and showed little. ALARM THE CITY settled off the pace, moved in to save ground on the turn and faltered.
