CAPABLE ARGUMENT quickly moved clear, dictated terms through the turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch and held gamely under strong urging. VUITTON chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker and finished willingly but missed. THAT'S ME broke a bit slow, moved up on the outside while urged along, chased three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, loomed a danger into the final furlong but was outfinished while clear for the show. PLAY SOLEIL was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. JUST JAN broke a bit slow, settled towards the rear, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. PRIVATEMARKETVALUE steadied outside the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention. DANCIN' LIL settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. LADY BERKLEY was urged along while off the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn and also failed to respond.
