ARTEMUS KITTEN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled while off the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and just held under strong urging. UPPERLINE went four wide on the first turn, was well placed behind the solo leader, came under urging while three to four wide on the far turn, angled five wide into the stretch, was put to drive, gained her best stride in the final furlong and closed well while drifting out but was too late. BET ON THE BLUE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. VERA BELLE bumped lightly with rivals at the start, went to the lead, raced four wide on the first turn, set the clear pace, remained clear while four wide on far turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. MOON STRUCK NEMI broke out and bumped lightly with a rival, settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn and failed to rally. MAGGIES RANSOM raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. CATEGORY SEVEN raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while three to four wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. (Rail at 7 Feet)
