Footnotes

RAZMATAZ tracked the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, cruised to the lead in upper stretch, was asked a bit coming to the furlong marker and edged clear while ridden out in an easy victory. ACE AND JIM settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide late on the bend, advanced into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. HUMOR'S PUNCH was rated off the pace, came under a very strong hold passing the half-mile pole, was rank off heels while under vigorous restraint leaving the backstretch, continued rank behind rivals until the three-eighths pole, dropped to the inside at the five-sixteenths pole, caused TOUGH BRUSH to check in the process, finally leveled out shortly thereafter, chased in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MR MISSILE set the clear pace, controlled the action while inside on the turn, was asked after straightening for the drive, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. TOUGH BRUSH was well placed just off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, checked sharply when HUMOR'S PUNCH dropped in at the five-sixteenths pole, moved off the rail shortly thereafter, was put to a drive in upper stretch and failed to rally. STRAY DOG settled off the pace, went three wide on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole and came up empty. ITS

CHAMPAGNE TIME settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. DOMINATION raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn and was no factor. CITY ORDINANCE settled off the pace, went four wide on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, hesitated between rivals in upper stretch and failed to respond. COLLEGE FUND leaned out at the start, settled towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention. NAFASS bobbed at the start then dropped back, raced at the rear of the field and trailed. Following the race, the stewards' conducted an inquiry into the run around the turn. After the review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
