Footnotes

KILN was hustled to the lead, set the clear pace, extended the advantage leaving the far turn and drew off under a strong hand ride. NIGHTLY MONOLOGUE was rated off the inside, raced inside early on the turn then moved off the rail, shifted three wide late on the bend, came four wide into the stretch, moved into second in the final furlong, had the rider lose his whip late and safely secured the place. OUTRIGHT VENTURE was bumped after the start, raced just off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, dropped to the inside in upper stretch and tired while able to get the show. HE'SAMIGHTYMINT settled off the pace, came under urging near the half-mile pole, went two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. KENZIE'S HEAT was forwardly placed on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. WAR CHANCELOR bumped with MONETARY UNION at the start then bumped with OUTRIGHT VENTURE, was taken up when KENZIE'S HEAT crossed over outside the half-mile pole, went five wide on the turn, dropped to four wide approaching the quarter-pole, lugged inward in upper stretch and came up empty. NIKKI'S PATH settled towards the rear, raced inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. PINECREST PIRATE tracked the pace, chased while off the rail on the turn and capitulated.

SOUP R LION settled off the pace, dropped back under some restraint midway through the turn and failed to respond. MONETARY UNION bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the outside, went six wide on the turn and was no factor. BAYOU ONE broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn and showed little. COYOTE CHASER broke two to three lengths slow, raced at the rear and trailed.
