FRIEND OF INDY went to the front, chose the three path on the first turn, set the pace while well off the rail, controlled the action while three wide on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under strong urging. SLIGEAUX BEAU broke in at the start, raced near the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, pursued the winner determinedly in the final furlong but missed. HAYNESVILLE SHALE bumped with KISS MY KRISS early, went six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, was unhurried at the rear, moved closer while inside on the far turn, shifted out while chasing in upper stretch, angled further out near the furlong marker and finished with good courage for the show. DEADLY CATCH bumped with rivals on both sides after the start, was rank while under restraint, threw his head repeatedly while

fighting the rider, settled more kindly on the backstretch, moved closer with a half-mile to run, raced towards the inside on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. KISS MY KRISS bumped with rivals early, went five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced two to three wide on the far turn, was urged along in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. REBEL SKY went seven then six wide on the first turn, settled on the far outside, raced five wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SECOND LION bumped with an opponent after the start, was rated while tracking the leader, went four wide on the far turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. ORDINARY TIME bumped with rivals on both sides early, was turned sideways in the process, went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while six wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch and failed to respond. DEVIL IN A BOTTLE went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased five wide on the far turn and tired. LITTLE DOLLAR bumped with DEADLY CATCH after the start, was taken in hand early, settled on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 0 Feet)
