Footnotes

STAR GUITAR went five to six wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while four to five wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied in the final furlong and closed well to get up at the wire. POPULIST POLITICS went four to five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went four wide on the far turn, was asked after straightening for the drive, made a bid passing the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. GET IN DA HOUSE settled towards the rear, went three then four wide on the far turn, rallied on the outside and closed well to just miss. STRING KING set the clear pace, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and was outfinished. PRODUCTIVE ENVOY raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE brushed with a rival after the start, was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. HEAVENVILLE raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled in second position, chased on the far turn and tired. CANDIANO brushed with a rival after the start, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. MAN OF STRIFE raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor.
