Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since January 1st, allowed 2 lbs. \$25,000 since December 1st, 2011, allowed 4 lbs, \$18,000 since then, allowed 6 lbs. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2011-2012. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, March 17, 2012, with 20 nominations. KISSIMMEE KYLE was urged along while off the pace, dropped in to save ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker and drew clear under steady handling. CLASSY DEELITES was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. SWEET LITTLE SLEET settled while under some urging, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. AMANECER DE ORO chased the pace, made a bid while two to three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. CHIEF JAY raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and improved position. PATRYKUS was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SIR MAXWELL

was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and also failed to rally. SOUTHERN DUDE chased the pace on the outside, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. SU CASA G CASA was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. TORO BRAVO was urged along in the front half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. ROYAL PRODUCTION set the pace, vied into the stretch and gave way. (Rail at 7 Feet)
