SACHEM SPIRIT raced five then four wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, moved to a clear lead, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held well while drifting out. PARABELLUM went three to four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. MADRIS raced four then three wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and settled for the show. ATTENDANT settled on the inside, dropped back early on the far turn, came off the rail, was put to a drive in upper stretch and improved position. MAJOR HOPE settled while off the rail, was roused on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SOUND EFFECT was reserved at the rear of the field, swung out at the top of the stretch and also improved position. SEWANEE was unhurried at the back, went three wide on the far turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to menace. THIRSTY THURSDAY went four to five wide on

the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. BAYOU VERMILION raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, shifted inward in upper stretch and weakened. DONOHARM went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn and also failed to rally. SENOR PELIGROSO raced three wide into the first turn then moved to the inside, dropped back early on the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and came up empty. SPEED SCORE went four wide on the first turn, was reserved in the middle of the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LA FAMILLE was reserved on the inside, saved ground on both turns and faded. (Rail at 7 Feet)
