CASINO HOST went three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, went four to five wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied on the outside, closed determinedly to get the lead late and gamely prevailed under strong urging. PAPA W BODIE went three then four wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was denied. JOINEM went three wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, came under urging while four then five wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. MR. VEGAS went to the lead, raced three wide on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, went two to three wide on the far turn, was asked after being straightened for the drive, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished. SLOW PACE settled while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn, made a bid along the rail in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished. SWIFT WARRIOR went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. SMART BID saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved to the outside, came under a drive and lacked the needed response. WILKINSON was reserved off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and also lacked the needed response. WILLYCONKER (IRE) broke in at the start then moved up, settled on the inside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, raced inside on the far turn, came under a drive in

upper stretch and gave way. SUNTRACER raced three wide on the first turn, lagged well behind, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and trailed. (Rail at 7 Feet)
