Footnotes

DAY TRIPPI narrowly showed the way early, garnered a slightly larger lead early turn, shrugged off a bid from the runner up past the furlong, quickly drew well clear. TRUE BLUE EYES asked a bid early too stay close, ranged up to challenge the winner late in the bend, raced on equal terms past the furlong marker then proved no match. ANGEL IN CHARGE lacked speed, made an advance on the outside into the lane, no threat to the top two. HELLA BELLA in tight at the start, in hand behind the pace early, moved out a bit for the drive, went evenly to the wire in lacking a late kick. MISS ACAPULCO void of early foot, improved position in the stretch while never dangerous. PEGGY SUS PATH lacked a late kick. O NIGHT DIVINE came up empty for the drive after saving ground. NILE TIGRESS was not involved with a wide trip. WIN WIN WIN pressed the winner early and stopped.
