COOL BULLET broke alertly, allowed the leader to go early, continued to press while in hand, took over turning for home, called on for a bit of some run nearing the furlong marker, quickly clear, ridden out. SIR BENTLEY prompted the pace while three wide through the turn, no match in the drive, edged clear for the place. STAR FRIDAY steadied at the start, finished up best of the rest. REBEL JET cleared soon after the start, showed the way through the turn inside, faltered when replaced on the lead by the winner into the lane. BRUNNERA lacked a response in the drive. TONTO FONTENOT no threat, remained back. HEY RED lacked speed, came four wide out of the turn, lacked a rally.
