Footnotes

MOONSTRUCK BERTIE outrun early along the inside, steered out a bit turning for home, evenly paced in some traffic past the furlong marker, dropped to the rail late, just up. RIVER BARROW lacked early foot, fanned five wide exiting the turn, roused, rallied outside, late bid, outfinished. TRUE BLUE EYES within striking distance, took over while along the rail late turn, shook well clear, faltered from between the top two late. WAY TOO HIGH off the early pace, loomed a mild threat four wide late in the turn, hung. THUNDERING GALLOP lacked speed, four wide out of the turn, managed little in the way of a rally while continuing out in the strip. GOLD DIGGIN DIVA prompted the pace for a half and tired. CALL ME KITTY CAT a bit slow in leaving, was never a threat. HIGH KICKING DREAM controlled the pace for almost a half, allowed the show horse the rail midway turn, gave way when headed.
