### Footnotes

TARALICIOUS brushed with a rival at the start, showed great speed, dictated terms through the turn, drew off while along the rail in upper stretch, responded very poorly when put to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker, bolted towards the outside fence, had the rider nicely maintain balance in the process, was held together while just five or six lengths off the outside rail and crossed the wire safely while much the best. CHOCOLAT CITY chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. YES SIR was ridden along towards the rear, raced four then five wide on the turn and got up for the show. ANTE UP ANNIE was beaten for early speed, raced inside on the turn and narrowly missed the show. ANOTHER SHOES was urged along while just off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. UNDER THE RADAR settled behind rivals, dropped back and lost position outside the seven-sixteenths pole, raced towards the inside on the turn, steadied when LYDIAN EMPIRE came in after straightening for the drive and improved some position. SKIPAWAYWITHBING showed speed while behind the leader, was taken in hand near the half-mile pole, chased along the rail on the turn and tired. SWEET IDE settled while under some urging, went three wide on the turn and failed to respond. DREAMGLIDER dropped back at the start, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. WINSKY ALEXANDRA was ridden along while off the pace, went four wide on the turn and came up empty. LYDIAN EMPIRE brushed with a rival at the start then was sent, chased the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, came in and bothered UNDER THE RADAR near the three-sixteenths pole and faded.
