Footnotes

DIVINE LORRETTA was in tight nearing the first turn, went four wide on that bend, was unhurried towards the back, went two to three wide on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, moved further to the outside while put to a drive, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. MALIBU HOLIDAY went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced quickly leaving the backstretch, circled four wide on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenth pole, battled gamely with a short lead into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. MYRIAD bumped lightly with a rival just after the start, was caught six wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but missed while able to get the show. CLOUD SCAPES went three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and finished with good energy. MISS ADDISON raced off the rail on the first turn, was well placed

just off the pace, came under some urging while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch, chased the leading duo into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. CANDY PAINT angled in early, lingered well back in the field, swung six wide into the stretch and improved position. NORTH BY NORTHLITE bumped lightly with a rival just after the start, went five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, came off the inside at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. DEFERRED went two to three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch and gave way. NUMBER ONE GAL settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. FASIG GIRL raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. HOW PLEASANT contested the pace on the outside, came under urging on the far turn, dropped out at the top of the stretch and faded. ARCHERETTE went three wide on the first turn, raced towards the front, came up empty on the far turn and stopped then was eased but walked off. (Rail at 0 Feet)
