TEN NINE EIGHT off the pace, challenged on the outside, long drive, proved best under spirited handling. CHINCHILLA reluctant to load, raced forwardly, challenged, outfinished. STELLALUNAR well back, came five wide into the stretch, did not have enough late kick. INAMONTHOFSUNDAYS chased the early leader, engaged that one and put a head in front past the furlong marker, was headed himself soon after, in tight a sixteenth out, weakened. MOUNTAIN SONG cleared soon after the start, was tiring when drifting out deep stretch. MINUTE MAIDEN off the pace, displayed some late interest. SILVER BREEZE steadily faded. HAD TO BEE was never involved. STORM ROYALE also was always outrun.
