SIR RABBIT unhurried in the early going, ranged up to challenge three wide late in the final turn, gained the advantage and proved best under steady handling. MIDDLEWEIGHT also lacked early speed, bit closer while four wide second turn, finished willingly for the place. WILD SUNDAY (GB) off the pace between foes for the drive, not enough in the late going. CERTAIN CIRCLES chased the leader, managed a brief bid nearing the furlong maker, weakened. MAN NAMED SUE pace, faltered in the drive along the inside. ROYAL PRICE (GER) finished after five furlongs, faded. MATZOH TOGA restless in the gate, rider hit the gate at the break, unseated.
