Footnotes

QUIETDETERMINATION raced off the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, angled further to the outside, closed strongly while outside the middle of the course and got up at the wire. AT THE PULPIT went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead outside the furlong marker, drifted out while moving clear and was denied at the wire. MAJOR GAIN lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, moved in for room near the furlong marker and finished well for the show. PURGENALITY went four wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, moved closer on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, advanced into a good striking range, chased into the final furlong and was outfinished. FIGHTER was a bit rank into the first turn, settled more kindly while well placed on the backstretch, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. KISS MY KRISS went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FATTY LANGBEIN settled on the inside, moved up significantly with a half-mile to run, drafted behind the leader on the far turn, waited a bit leaving that bend, was asked after straightening for the drive and also lacked the needed kick. WHEEMAWAY brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, prompted the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure while three wide on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. SAINT FLOYD was caught six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, settled towards the front while on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. WARRIOR'S HIT set the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
