BEANWAH'SMACHINE was away alertly, tracked the leader on the outside, was asked a bit near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when asked for more nearing the furlong marker, took the lead passing that marker and edged clear under steady handling. BUCKTOWN bumped with a rival at the start, moved up to take the lead, set the pace on the inside, extended the advantage some on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead entering the final furlong and proved no match while well clear for the place. BALIDOR DESOL bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and was best of the rest. MISTER TRISTAN bumped soundly with DELIGHTED DISCIPLE at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. DELIGHTED DISCIPLE bumped soundly with MISTER TRISTAN at the start, moved up while shifting to the outside, was urged along while three wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and tired. LANDOPEDUSA dropped back while urged along, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. IRISH CONFIDANT was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
