Footnotes

CORNICELLI broke out a bit at the start, dropped towards the inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the spread out field, was roused on the far turn, moved out some in upper stretch and closed well to get up late. JACK AND MAX pressed the leader on the outside, drew even on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while able to maintain the place. ANNA'S GLORY settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, moved out in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. J. BURLE set the pace along the inside, came under pressure on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and tired. HOWELL PARK broke out at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. MONEYONTHEGRASS broke two to three lengths slow, angled in towards the back, lagged near the rear of the field, was urged along on the far turn, angled out sharply in upper stretch and improved position. ALVIN AND DAVID bumped with a rival at the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. TRACK BULLY raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three

then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. CAJUN CONQUEST raced well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. JUSTACLOWN bumped with a rival at the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went four then five wide on the far turn and faltered. SOCCER PRINCE saved ground on the turns and also faltered.
