Footnotes

BOSTON BOSS chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, shifted further out to go around a drifting GET IT, rallied in the final furlong and caught the tired leader near the wire. TWO MINUTE LICK showed good speed, controlled the action in front, raced off the rail on the turn, drew off in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but shortened stride and was caught. BOOK OF RULES was ridden along while off the pace, raced mostly three wide on the turn, moved out some in the final furlong and just earned the show. JACIS SUNNY FRIEND broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, advanced into the stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and just missed the show. MAN OF DISTINCTION was urged along while off the pace, moved out on the turn, made his way to four wide by the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out some after straightening for the drive and failed to rally. COLD DARK NIGHT chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and tired. EARL AND VINEGAR was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide early on the turn, dropped in near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. GET IT chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn and came up empty.
