Footnotes

THUNDER CHOP chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, battled with CAYENNE NATIVE in upper stretch, was carried out by that rival near the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. CAYENNE NATIVE crossed over and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, battled with the winner in upper stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and was outfinished while just able to hold the place. OVER IT was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and finished willingly for the show. STRIKIN IKE settled while under some urging, went three wide on the turn and also finished willingly. RACING CAJUN was hustled and showed early speed, raced just behind the leader, drafted behind that rival while inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. AMBROSE THE GREAT dropped back at the start, raced at the rear, saved ground on the turn and finished with late energy but never reached serious contention. DEWBERRY was urged along while just off the pace, chased three to four wide on the turn and tired. MY DADDY HEIR was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. THEIRBANKINGONME was urged along towards the rear, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. DR. PELTIER was urged along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and came up empty.
