IVE STRUCK A NERVE bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, gained the lead inside the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. LEDOKOL showed good speed, moved to the lead near the half-mile pole, inched clear near the five-sixteenths pole, led into the final furlong, was headed by the winner then outfinished while clear for the place. DOC ALMON was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. CRUACHAN chased the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and tired. EDDIE JUNIOR was bumped on both sides at the start then dropped back, went three then four wide on the turn and failed to respond. BLOW BY EM bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. I'M IN TO HAPPY showed good speed, contested the pace, vied off the rail on the turn and faded. CHIEF EXE OFFICER showed early speed, pressed the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn and stopped.
