KELLY'SPREMONITION was rated while three wide on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, advanced on the outside to contest the lead, inched clear while three wide on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, maintained a safe advantage into the final sixteenth and held sway under steady urging. THEATRICAL'S HALO raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but was too late. WILLIST raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn and finished willingly for the show. SPEIGHTSTOWN SON raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn, dropped behind the leader near the five-sixteenths pole, continued on willingly in the stretch and just missed the show. WAJIR ON ME was reserved at the back of the field, came under a ride on the far turn, moved out nearing the sixteenth-pole and reached his best stride too late. RARE FLYER raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed towards the outside, shifted over heels outside the half-mile pole, was urged while four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. LUDMIG contested the pace, dropped back on the final turn and came up empty. ATTEMPTED HUMOR came

away awkwardly, was well placed just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and also came up empty. DOCTOR BRASCH settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. TUCKY settled on the inside, checked sharply outside the quarter-pole and dropped out. CAJUN PRIZE prompted the pace on the inside, drew even with a half-mile to run, vied inside on the far turn and stopped.
