Footnotes

JUST SAY HEY went four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, wisely chose to stay towards the inside on the far turn, dropped to the rail and was asked outside the quarter-pole, rallied along the fence in upper stretch, drew alongside BLUE KIMONO entering the final furlong, wrested the lead from that rival while brushing slightly and edged clear late under strong handling. BLUE KIMONO set the clear pace while on the inside, came under some urging on the far turn, moved out a bit after straightening for the drive, fought on determinedly when challenged by the winner, brushed slightly with that rival and was outfinished late but just held the place. FLASHY FOOL went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under urging while four then five wide on the far turn, chased in the center of the course into the final furlong and finished willingly for the show. GOLDIE'S REWARD went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. SWAN PARADISE tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the final furlong and also lacked the needed kick. SO HEAVENLY moved out entering the first turn, raced three wide on that bend, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. FOREVER BLUE was rank nearing the first then then steadied, raced at the back while on the inside, moved up some midway down the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and failed to threaten.
